

Step 1


1. Type the address of your Moodle site into your browser.
2. Click on the LOGIN button at the top right.
3. Register with an email address and password.
4. Create a course.



Step 2

You can invite students to your course.

You can share resources with learners or direct them to various exercises.



Step 3

You can then upload course materials.
You also have the possibility to create a place to deposit an assignment requested from the students, adapting the format of the file and the time determined to complete the work.
