HOW TO USE?




Download the free font and use it on different media (word, website...)

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
Step 1.

- Go to <u>https://www.opendyslex</u> ic.org/
- Click the "Download Free" button.



Step 2.

It should open the folder containing the fonts. If it does not open automatically, just go to your downloads folder and find the OpenDyslexic2 folder. Click on each of the 4 fonts and press the "download" button.



Step 3.

Open your WORD application. In the list of fonts, you will now find the Opendyslexic font!
