Using multi-sensory approach to teach

Adapt the texts to different levels of sensory competencies.

Teachers can use three types of multi-sensory techniques:


- Visual: the first student has reading, hearing and attention related difficulties. You can explain the human body using graphic organizers to better catch his/her attention.
- Auditory: the second student has learning related disorder and difficulties. She/he needs support in reading the text, so software can be used to perform this function, both in the classroom and at home.
- Kinesthetic: the third student has difficulties with dyscalculia and ADHD. Together with the class, perform simple mathematical operations using a numbered mat: in turn, each student jumps on the chosen numbers and the correct result.

Useful for all kinds of learning styles:

- SLD (Specific Learning Disorders and ADHD)
- Visual impairment
- Hearing impairment

Visual approach:

Using the **Mindomo** app, create a conceptual map of the human body to bring out the connections:



In your mindmap, you can use different colors to enhance links and content:





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Auditory approach:

Use **Immersive Reading** when showing part of the exercise to the class.

Next, assign the reading task to the students on a Word document. This way the student can use the free Immersive Reader tool at home:

Halted, he peered down the dark winding stairs and called out coarsely:


—Come up, Kinch! Come up, you fearful jesuit!
